

Imagine winding your way down the single-track road, no tents, no cooking pots, no food (that you had to spend 2hrs in the supermarket buying), just you and your Cubs, Scouts, Explorers or Network members. You start to get a feeling of the marvellous setting you and your young people are about to experience and you can sit back and relax knowing that your time will be spent either joining in with the activities or relaxing — **no programme to run, no catering to be done.**

The Lochgoilhead Centre is nestled in the hills close to the lochside and opens its doors to all sections, including Scouts with special needs. The wide range of activities both on water and land are offered as a come and try fun activity session or they may lead to an Activity Badge or a National Qualification.

The Centre is AALA registered and activities are taught by friendly and enthusiastic staff.

### Activity Weekends

This is a two-night multi choice activity weekend providing two morning and two afternoon activity sessions. It is available all year round and is designed to introduce participants to a wide range of activities run as taster sessions. Suitable for ages from eight years upward, we organize the programme to suit individual age, ability and weather conditions.



### Summer Activity Weeks

This is a very popular activity week. During your stay you will have the opportunity to try out a variety of activities and, for a small additional charge, take part our optional evening activity badge programme, such as Dinghy Sailor, Canoeist, Dragon Boat, Master at Arms, Climber and more.

### Courses

The centre runs a number of national sailing, canoeing, kayaking, walking, climbing, powerboating and first aid training courses.
