

CALEDONIAN RALLY 2009

The 2009 Caledonian Rally is again taking place at its long time home on the banks of the Caledonian Canal at Dochgarroch. The activity camp for Scouts and Guides aged 13-17 takes place over the weekend 16-18 October just 4 miles south of Inverness on the A82



As last year there will be 360 participant places available. The feedback from last year has been taken on board and all the teams have been working hard to make the Rally even better

How do I Apply

The Cally Rally is open to Scouts and Guides aged 13-17. The camp fee is £30 per child and varies for adults (see adult application form for details of the three fees and what they involve). This should be sent along with completed application forms (photocopy as necessary). A £5 discount per participant (i.e. Scouts and Guides) is available to those who apply before 31st August. The deadline for applications is 30 September. Last year we had a waiting list so get your forms in early to avoid disappointment. **Please remember that all these forms are for use by the Cally Rally only. You will still need to complete camp forms as required by your association i.e. NAN forms for Scouts and AA Forms for Guides**

How do I get there

Inverness is well served by public transport. Arrive by train, bus or plane! You can be picked up from Inverness for a £2 per person donation. Let us know your ETA. If travelling with your own transport it is easy to find the site - Honest! From the South head up the A9 until you reach the roundabout (i.e. leave Perth and wait until you get to a roundabout!). Turn left at roundabout onto the A82. **From the North cross the Kessock Bridge and turn right (3rd exit) onto the A82. From the East at the end of the A96 go North on the A9 for 1 mile until you get to the roundabout and turn left onto the A82.** Once on the A82 follow the signposts for Fort William.

You will come to the Harbour Rd Roundabout - carry straight on (dual carriageway) (beware of speed limit change from 70-30mph - police like to sit around this area)
come to the Rose Street roundabout - carry straight on (2nd exit - still dual carriageway);
next is Shore Street roundabout - carry straight on (2nd Exit - dual carriageway - crossing the river)
come to Telford St roundabout - left turn (2nd Exit - single carriageway - still A82)
Carry on through 1st set of traffic lights and turn right at next set - still A82
You are now on the road out of Inverness - about 1 mile on you will cross the canal and head towards the countryside - about 3 miles on you will see the campsite on your left.

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STAFF INFORMATION SHEET

The Caledonian Rally takes place over the weekend 18-20 October 2009 in the Highlands of Scotland. It is an activity camp for Scouts and Guides aged 13 - 17. All staff are required from Friday night to Sunday afternoon. We do however need staff before the camp starts and after it finishes. If you can help let us know. There are many varied tasks that we need camp staff to perform. **All staff must be 18 years of age and over.**

What is the cost?

There are two fees for staff members. £20 will cover your camp fees and all your meals starting with Saturday breakfast. If you do not wish staff catering then the fee is £7.

What can I do?

ACTIVITIES TEAM

By far the largest staffing requirement. We will be putting on activities for 360 participants. Activities take place all day Saturday and Sunday morning. More info on activities can be found on the website. **We require photocopies of qualifications and activity authorisations**

SITE SERVICES

Join the camp warden and his team in making sure the nuts and bolts of the site continue to operate.

CATERING

Help in the kitchen to prepare and serve staff meals or in the Monster's Lair - our very own fast food outlet.

EVENING ENTERTAINMENT

Help with the evening programme. On the Friday night you will be involved in the quiz - handing out sheets, taking in and marking answer sheets. On Saturday you will assist in the "casino". Tasks involve supervising the participants and running the games

MUSTERBOARD HOLDER

All activity groups have a musterboard holder. You are the Group Leader and make sure that all the group are together and get to their activity bases on time.

TRANSPORT

Can you drive a minibus. Transport drivers are used to transport Scouts and Guides between Inverness and the site if they use public transport. Then during the weekend some off site activities require participants to be taken to the activity base.

SECURITY

Assisting our Security team leader with keeping the site safe and challenging inappropriate behaviour from participants. This roll also involves site patrols during the evenings. You will be allocated to a shift so you are not on duty all day

QUARTERMASTER

Quartermasters - Assist the land and water activity co-ordinators with looking after the equipment - ensuring kit is

Be part of the First Aid cover team for the weekend
